We welcome anybody who wants to try archery with a view to taking up the sport & joining our club. Our instructors will teach you the right technique & ensure you know how to shoot safely.

Courses are a minimum of 6 hours spread over 3 or 4 weeks

You must confirm your place with the club prior to the course starting – numbers are strictly limited and we cannot accommodate people on the day.

A course normally consists of weekly 2 hour sessions. If it's necessary to cancel a lesson due to bad weather, or if you know in advance that you'll miss a particular week (e.g. if you are on holiday), then it can be made up later. If you're unable to attend a particular lesson please let us know beforehand. We cannot accept beginners into the Club unless they have received a minimum of 6 hours coaching.

Cost

The fee for each course is - **Senior £65 Junior £35.00** **Please note payment is non-refundable**

Juniors

We allow juniors of age 10 years and above to apply to join the beginner's course. However, acceptance of each junior on the course is subject to the approval of the coach. Juniors must be accompanied by parents, or parentally approved guardians, at all times.

Equipment

We provide all the equipment for the course. Please, **do not buy any equipment** yourselves. If you join the club after the course, we can offer bows for hire, or offer advice to help you purchase your own equipment.

Clothing

You should wear comfortable but close-fitting clothing. If it's chilly it's better to wear several thin layers rather than one bulky one & perhaps bring a woolly hat. In particular it's important that you don't wear jumpers or jackets with baggy sleeves as bow strings tend to catch on them & spoil your shot!
